Our first stop will be a tour through the Georgia O'Keeffe Museum guided by a professional docent. Welcoming more than 2,225,000 visitors from all over the world and being the most visited art museum in the state of New Mexico, it is the only museum in the world dedicated to an internationally known American woman artist. One of the most significant artists of the 20th century, Georgia O'Keeffe (1887-1986) was devoted to creating imagery that expressed what she called "the wideness and wonder of the world as I live in it." The Museum's collection of over 3,000 works comprises 1,149 O'Keeffe paintings, drawings, and sculptures that date from 1901 to 1984.



Next you will enjoy a hosted lunch at La Casa Sena. Situated in the historic house built by Major Jose Sena in the 1860s, La Casa Sena features an internationally acclaimed menu drawn from the best in Santa Fe and southwestern cuisine. An incomparable collection of museum-quality paintings adds to the ambiance.

After lunch you'll be taking a driving tour with our professional tour guide, pointing out areas of interest such as the Santa Fe Ski area, Canyon Road, and the Plaza area. Founded in 1610, Santa Fe was the last stop on the Camino Real, the fabled Royal Road that stretched from Mexico City to the northernmost reaches of the Spanish Empire. Today it is the heart and soul of the Southwest, and "Santa Fe Style" is synonymous with all the best the region has to offer. Its historic Plaza, winding streets, covered arcades, hidden gardens and courtyards, and Pueblo-style architecture reflect the blending of Indian, Hispanic, and Anglo cultures. Free time will be offered based on timing.
